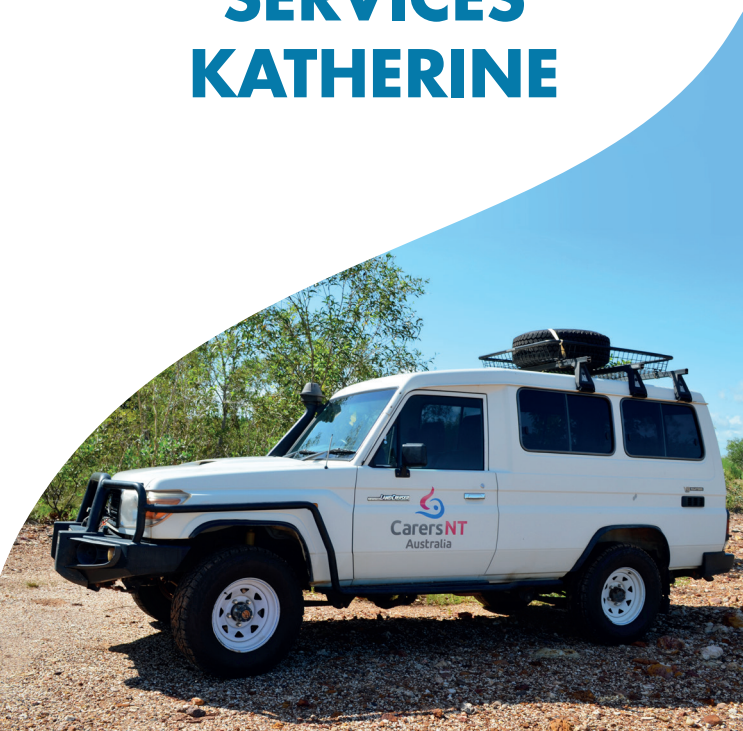

Burnet Place

Centre based respite provides respite in a group setting. Centre based respite is based on group activities aimed at maintaining independence and re-enablement. It provides respite in a warm, friendly and secure environment.

Flexible Respite

Flexible respite is a service, which provides daytime or overnight support for clients in their own home. This enables the carer to have small regular breaks from their caring role, knowing their loved one is being cared for in a familiar environment.

Flexible Respite Camps

Respite camps are scheduled during the dry season and give frail aged Indigenous persons the opportunity to participate in activities on country. The camps are up to 5 days and provide respite for the carer.

A bush camp is set up in an area in agreement with the community. The group collectively explore options for outings and activities allowing choice and control to the participants. Some of the activities included may be fishing, hunting, digging for roots or clay to collect colour for dying, picking bush tucker and collecting plants for various uses.
